Message: Don't be duped by the devil

Passage: Revelation 17

17: 1

A woman is always the symbol of a r\_\_\_\_\_ system or movement-good or bad.

In Gen 11: 1-9, Nimrod persuaded his peers to build a tower to gather people in one place and give allegiance to a system of worship of something other than God.

God had told them to scatter and populate the entire world. This gathering was in defiance to God.

They called their city, Bab-El, or gate of God but it was changed to Babel which means confusion by God's judgment on their efforts.

The Plain of Shinar where Babel was built became the center of the future nation of Babylon which is modern day Iraq.

Ancient writings tell us that the wife of Nimrod was Semiramis the First, the founder of the Babylonian mystery religions and first high priestess of idolatry.

Thus, Babylon became synonymous with idolatry. Much like the term "Wall Street symbolizes the financial system of America, Babylon is a metaphor for a false religious system.

She bore a son who legend says was miraculously conceived and when he was born, he was proclaimed the promised deliverer.

Thus, was introduced the mystery and worship of the woman and child, a from of idolatry that has existed since near the beginning of humanity.

The rites of this religion were secret, only the initiated knew the secrets.

According to Jeremiah 51:7, Babylon has always represented a false religion of secrets, sexual desires, superstition, humanism and idolatry.

17: 1:

"Waters she sits on" = see v 15 as this refers to the c she has over most of the world
17: 3
She has names of b, showing how religion has fallen from Christ.
17:4:
Clothed in purple= the c of Roman imperialism and todays  Catholicism
Gold= beauty on the outside but i on the inside
Golden cup= shows that it is c Christianity
17:5: Name upon her forehead= She does not wear a c but rather the m of her profession.
17:6: Persecution of God's people has always been a mark of a false religious system.
17:7: This is a totalitarian state and an anti-Christian church combining to control humanity.
17:8: Seven heads=this probably refers to 7 k as mountains often are symbolic of kings or kingdoms.
17:11: The antichrist is the 7 <sup>th</sup> head who seemingly dies mid-Tribulation but is brought back to life (again an i of the resurrection by the devil). This also makes him the 8 <sup>th</sup> ruler as indicated in verse 11.
17: 12-13
These ten heads correspond to the ten t of the king's vision in Danial 2 and the ten horns of Danial 7 and Revelation 13.
17: 15-17: All this continues until the antichrist and these world leaders gather at the Valley of Megiddo in the last rebellious act of humanity against God. The Lord will overthrow them completely.
17:18
God uses the evil Beast to destroy the false religious system. Thus, the Beast actually carries out the will of God without realizing it.
